We're so excited to step back in time and groove to the rhythm of the flower power filled 70's at the Forte Showcase! Get ready to be transported to an era of disco balls, psychedelic colors and groovy beats as our talented dancers and twirlers bring the spirit of the seventies to life on stage. This packet will serve as your itinerary filled with all the very important details for your dancer's and twirler's performance(s). Please take time to read and save this as a reference tool as we lead up to your dancer's big day!

Venue & Parking

This year our Showcase will be held at Lassiter Concert Hall (2601 Shallowford Rd, Marietta, GA 30066).



The show will kick off on Sunday, May 12, 2024 at 4 p.m. and conclude at approximately 5 p.m. **Performers are required to arrive no later than 2 p.m. with their hair and makeup done.** More details are on page 4.

Parking is free. You are welcome to park in the parking lot outside of Lassiter Concert Hall.



Timeline

Drop-off time is 2 p.m. for ALL classes. All students should be dropped off having eaten lunch already.

Students will need to be dropped off at 2 p.m. with full hair and makeup done and in their costume (more details on page 4). Forte staff will greet your dancer in the lobby to check them in and then walk them to their waiting room backstage. Parents, you will need to exit the venue and then return before show time when doors open. We cannot have guests in the lobby/concert hall during rehearsal.

All dancers will be with Forte staff **at all times**. Additionally, we will have designated staff members assigned to each class inside the waiting rooms backstage. Dancers will be monitored at all times and escorted by at least one adult.

Once all dancers have arrived and settled, we will have a dress rehearsal on stage prior to show time.

Doors open for ticketed guests at 3:30 p.m.! There is plenty of seating in the concert hall, so there are no assigned seats. The show will begin promptly at 4 p.m. We will not have an intermission. The show will conclude by 5 p.m.

After the show, we will check dancers out with their parents. Any dancer ages 10+ will be dismissed from the stage. Any dancer ages 4-9 years old will be dismissed from the lobby. **Dancers will only be released to parents and need to be checked out.**

Dancers will not be allowed to sit with family in the audience after their performance. Additionally, no dancer may be dismissed early from the show.



Costumes, Hair and Makeup

All dancers have received their costume(s) from the studio. Along with their costume, each dancer received a pair of tights and a hair accessory. Please make sure your dancer comes dressed in their tights and costume with hair and makeup done. Don't forget your dance shoes! Dancers can wear sneakers or other shoes into the concert hall. See page 6 for a checklist of what to bring.

Hair

We have two hairstyles for our Showcase, both buns. Your hairstyle is determined by your dancer's age and is also listed on their costume description in their garment bag.

Ages 4-9: High straight back bun (also known as a Ballet Bun)

Ages 10+: Middle part low bun



There are some great YouTube tutorials for this hairstyle too. Here is a video we recommend: Middle Part Low Bun

Makeup

Makeup is recommended but not required! The lights on the stage are very bright, and the concert hall is large. Makeup helps their beautiful faces to not be washed out by the lights and to better stand out on stage.

For the younger dancers, we suggest blush, mascara and lipstick/lip gloss. The older dancers should wear blush, lipstick and eye makeup. All dancers should look their best for the big day!

Again, YouTube has some great recital makeup tutorials. Here are some we recommend: Makeup for Little Girl; Makeup for Big Girl.



Dancer Checklist

Please send any items with your dancer packed neatly in a small dance bag and/or backpack. Do not send extra stuffed animals, blankets, etc. Backstage is busy and we need everyone to keep their items organized and neat. Thank you!

Garment bags for costumes in addition to a dance bag are welcome! There will be rolling racks to hang garment bags on in the waiting rooms for costume changes. That is the preferred method if your dancer is in more than one performance. **All dancers should arrive in a costume -** see the Show Order on the next page to see which costume you should arrive in first if you are in more than one dance.

As a reminder, each dancer received **four tickets**. Each family was emailed a unique code to redeem their tickets. If you have any questions or need help finding the email, please email clay@fortedancetwirl.com before the day of show.

We also ask that you consider our dancers and other audience members when bringing young children to watch. For some dancers this may be their first time on stage and we want to minimize distractions for performers. Please step into the lobby to reset if needed before heading back in to enjoy the show.

Flower Power Fun!

In addition to the show, there will be lots of goodies and fun moments throughout the day!

Included in the Showcase package:

- **Showcase t-shirts:** Each performer will receive their Showcase t-shirt on the day of Showcase! They will wear this on stage during the Presentation at the end of the show.
- Studio gift: Each dancer will receive a SURPRISE gift from the studio during the finale!
- **Showcase video:** We will be filming our Showcase and will share this video <u>free of charge</u> with all participants after the performance. This will be shared via a YouTube link to all participants.

More flower power fun:

- Photo station in lobby: We're going to have a photo backdrop set up in the lobby of the
 venue for some fun photos! We would love for you to take photos of your dancer and tag
 us @fortedancetwirl. There will be plenty of time after the show to take as many photos
 as you'd like! During the performances we ask that there be no flash photography.
- Name wall: Every dancer will have their name displayed on a wall in the lobby as part of a groovy backdrop! After the show, dancers are welcome to take their name off the wall to take home with them.
- Items for sale: There will be a few goodies for sale in the lobby before and after the Showcase. Stop by our table to check out a limited supply of some special items, Forte merch and more! Payment will only be accepted via credit card (no Amex).
- Questions about summer? There will be a table set up with information about our summer classes and camps. Stop by to see what we have to offer!
